## Summary of Rules Changes for the 2011-12 School Year

### Adventurous Equations

- 1) EMJS – Limit of cubes in the goal is increased from five to six
- 2) Elem – Multiple operation variation is changed so that it applies to all operations, instead of just one that is selected at the time the variation is called. This is an odd-year variation that takes effect in the 2012-13 school-year.
- 3) Elem. – Add the Remainder variation to the odd-year variation list. When this variation is called a sideways divide sign may be used to represent the remainder when two number are divided (i.e 4 remainder 7 would be 7, 23 remainder 3 would be 2)
- 4) Senior – Students are allowed to call two variations at all Saturday tournaments
- 5) Senior – SW and USD are in automatically in effect for all shakes.
- 6) Junior / Senior – Novice Equations will be offered at all Saturday tournaments and at the State tournament, providing enough teams register to play it.
- 7) EMJS – The ^ symbol may be used interchangeably with the \* symbol for exponentiation, and is always to be placed upwards.
- 8) Junior / Senior – the ^ symbol is ambiguous when Base 11 or 12 is called (i.e it may be upside down or sideways)

### Basic Equations

- 1) The ^ symbol may be used interchangeably with the \* symbol for exponentiation, and is always to be placed upwards.

### Adv. On-Sets

- 1) Junior / Senior - Novice On-Sets will be offered at all Saturday tournaments and at the State tournament, providing enough teams register to play it.

### Linguishtik

- 1) Junior / Senior – Basic Linguishtik will be offered at all Saturday tournaments and at the State tournament, providing enough teams register to play it.

### WorldCard

- 1) The theme portion of the game has been eliminated and two round of current events will be played at the State Tournament.

### Presidents

- 1) This year's theme is Slogams
